Synthroid 25 mcg p.o. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, levothyroxine 50 mcg p.o. Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday, Tylenol 325 mg p.o. daily p.r.n. pain, multivitamin 1 tablet p.o. daily, magnesium oxide 250 mg p.o. daily, Norvasc 10 mg p.o. daily, Lipitor 40 mg p.o. daily at 2100, and Colace 200 mg p.o. daily p.r.n. constipation.

ASSESSMENT AND PLAN:
1. Dizziness. The patient was seen by ENT and Neurology. MRI showing no acute abnormality. She was sent to rehab today.
2. Coronary artery disease, stable.
3. Hypertension, stable. Continue on Norvasc.
4. Hyperlipidemia, on statin.
5. Hypothyroidism, on Levoxyl.

The patient was seen and examined with Dr. Plan of care discussed and formulated as above. The patient will be transferred to Country Rehab today.

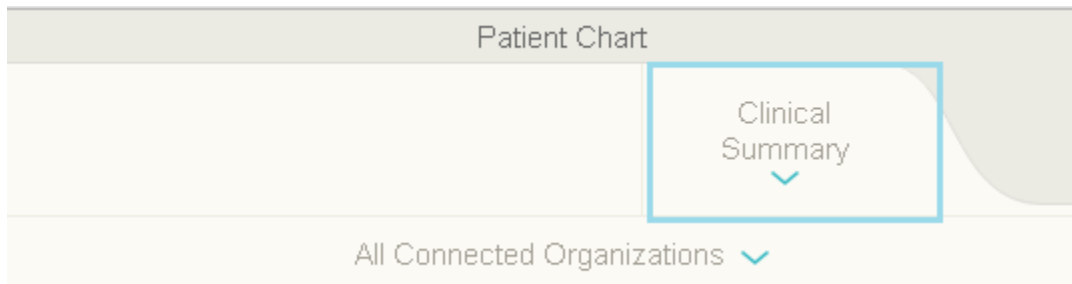
