Program Highlights

- » 3-month program starting Fall 2024
- » Mentors and mentees will be paired based on shared interests
- » Mentors and mentees will meet for at least 1 hour every two weeks
- » Mentees will have the opportunity to virtually network and support one another
- » Mentees will work on a Health IT focused project with the guidance of their mentor
- » Program will culminate in a virtual Project Showcase
