- » Program will culminate in a virtual project showcase

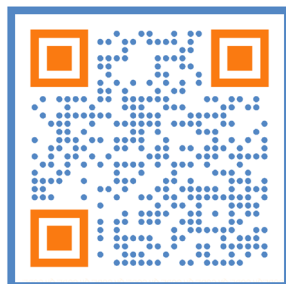
Mentee Profile
